

Size chart - Skinners Globetrotter I

NOTE! The size chart indicates the inner length and width OF THE SHOE in centimetres.

Measure your feet length as described down AND THEN add an extra 0.5-1.2 (1,5) cm to the length of your foot, and you will get the ideal size of your shoe.

The wider your foot the more you need to add extra space to get more width also.

(PETRI'S TIP - Globetrotter is a very flexible shoe in the toe area and therefore smaller extra length is sufficient compared to many other shoes in our selection. Choose the bigger model if you are in between two sizes.)

How to measure your foot correctly?

1) Place a blank A4-sized paper on a flat, smooth and even surface.

- 2) Step onto the paper with all your weight on the leg.
- 3) Use a pen/pencil to mark the heel and the farthest point from the heel (beware, it may not always be the big toe)
- 4) Measure the distance between these two points on feet with a ruler (the difference can be ± 0.5 cm)
- 5) The number obtained is the length of your foot
- 6) Add an extra 0.5-1.2 cm to the length of your foot, and you will get the ideal size of your shoe.
- 7) Find your correct shoe size from the above measurements by referring to the size chart.
